1. Rotation Schedule

Three 4-month blocks: Inpatient, Acute Residential and Partial, Elective

2. Inpatient Rotation (4 months @ 30 hours/week): Inpatient Unit at Franciscan Children's Hospital (latency)

- a. Supervision: Drs. Calligas and Stromberg
- b. Caseload: 3 treatment cases
- c. Group Therapy Supervisor: Dr. Powers
- d. Teaching of milieu staff is strongly encouraged
- e. On-call: (see pages 62-64)
- f. Psychopharmacology consultation: Franciscan and McLean staff

3. Partial Hospital (ART) Rotation (4 months @ 30 hours/week): McLean Hospital

- a. Supervision: each resident supervised individually and in group by attendings, Drs. Rater, Aguirre and Vo, et al. Additional supervision for psychopharmacology and multimodal treatment, walk rounds and individual supervision.
